Activities Request for 2019

At Long Bay Primary School we request \$75 per child to cover activities that enhance the classroom programmes. Examples of activities experienced by the children in 2018 included trips to Tiritiri Matangi, Auckland Zoo, Auckland Museum, Corbans Art Centre and Stardome. Other activities included access to the Mathletics website (for use at home and school), science activities and the Life Education Programme.

Although these activities are not compulsory they are programmes selected by the teaching staff to enhance the learning experiences for your child/ren.

New students who arrive during the school year and wish to participate with these activities will receive a notice and the adjustment in price to reflect the remaining amount.

Receipts will be sent home at the end of March 2019. If you choose to pay after this time then we will issue a receipt upon payment.

Families may be able to claim an income tax credit from the Inland Revenue Department in relation to donations made to the school. Please note if you pay by the 31st March 2019 you may be able to claim the tax credit within this tax year.
